


## Ventura County Population Profile

- Total population: 820,000
- White not Hispanic 54%, Hispanic origin 36%, Asian 6%, African American and Multi Racial 2%
- 28% of residents are >18 years
- 10% 65 or older


## Youth Ethnic Diversity - Children



## **Employment Profile**

- 68% of working age residents are in the labor force, including 65% of women with children under 18 years.
- 75,500 was the county's family median income in 2004, compared to the state median of 58,327.

## Family Violence Profile

- Child Abuse referrals
  - Referrals 2,959
  - Substantiated 772
- Child Removal Rate
  - Avg 30/month

- Domestic violence calls
  - -6,479
- DV filings:
  - Felonies 344
  - Misdemeanors 870

## Child Abuse Prevention Program

- Began October 2005
- Collaborative effort between HSA, PH & Juvenile Justice
- Funded by Cal Endowment, MCAH, HSA
- 6 nurses
- Referrals received primarily from CFS, courts & probation

## Program Goal

# Prevent child abuse and neglect and reduce recidivism rate in juvenile facility

- PHN home visitation services to children and families who are at risk for violence and abuse.
- Providing preventive education in a variety of community settings.

## Program Interventions

### Individual/Family

- Intensive home visitation
- Linkages to private and public entities
- Referrals to community resources

### **Community**

- High Schools
- Outpatient drug rehabs for moms and babies
- Preschools
- Probation

## **Program Outcomes**

- Since October 2005 program has served 2196 clients
- Comments found, "Don't spank your child 1st" and "I learned how to calm down"
  - Qualitative measures not formalized
- Quantitative measure
  - 96% Remain in the home
  - 4% CFS Removal Rate
- Recidivism Rate
  - 62%

### **Evaluation**

- Justice system values PHN contribution
- PHN's allow for a non threatening atmosphere
- Funding issues
- Standardized interventions
- Formalize qualitative data
