# Illustrating GIS Tools in Population Based Epidemiologic Research

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#### Geographic Information Systems (GIS)

Computer based system of hardware, software, and data used to create, manage, store, display, and analyze spatial and attribute data.





#### Sources of Data

- Study on cardiovascular health in 4 California cities
- 8,419 adults surveyed
- Home addresses geocoded and linked to census data to describe neighborhood social environment (e.g., poverty concentration)
- Addresses of goods and services geocoded to describe neighborhood physical environment (e.g., proximity/density alcohol outlets)






#### GIS Examples

- Disseminating findings






## Urban Comparison of Postal Service Zip Code Boundaries with Census Bureau Zip Code Boundaries, 2000








## Rural Comparison of Postal Service Zip Code Boundaries with Census Bureau Zip Code Boundaries, 2000








#### Geographic Representation of Study Participants by Neighborhood-Level Poverty Concentration Women Aged 25-74, Modesto, CA, 1979-1980








#### Density of Alcohol Outlets: Individual-Level










#### Density of Alcohol Outlets: Neighborhood-Level








#### Distance to Alcohol Outlets: Street Network Distance

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






#### Distance to Alcohol Outlets: Straight Line Distance


#### Straight Line Distance to Alcohol Outlet








#### 1980: Number of Fast Food Outlets by Percent Hispanic Concentration, Modesto, CA








#### 1990: Number of Fast Food Outlets by Percent Hispanic Concentration, Modesto, CA
