

## Agricultural Workers in California

- One million workers in California--generating \$30 billion annually.
- 1 in 3 Mexican immigrants in CA is in a farmworker household.
- 46% have lived in CA over 10 years
- Vast majority are non-citizens

**Rural Community Assistance Corporation** 

- Agricultural Worker Health and Housing Program (AWHHP) created February 1999
- \$30 Million/5 years to promote model health and housing programs

#### **AWHHP Key Successes and Learnings**

# 50 grants/loans - created 400 homes Leveraged over \$113M

## **AWHHP Policy Victories**

- Joe Serna Health and Housing Law passed
- Prop. 46 \$120M in new public money for farmworker housing



## **AWHHP Health Improvements**

Improved health and well being through emphasis on *home* and *community*
