African Origins

Geneticists indicate that modern Homo sapiens evolved 200,000 years ago in the migrations of East Africa. Geneticists agree, tracing the mitochondrial DNA of everyone alive today back to an ancestral female who lived in the region roughly 190,000 years ago. This "Eve" is named by an "Adam" who dwelt on these same savannas about 60,000 years ago, leaving behind to every male today a common Y-chromosome legacy of the several hominid species then existing, including other kinds of early humans, people today probably sprung from just one small tribe of hunter-gatherers, perhaps a little smaller, more linguistically advanced, and possessing better tools than their neighbors.

Dink Kilim Sabtu

Dismantled near Ethiopia's Omo River, this skull has recently been dated at 194,000 years old, making it among the most ancient Homo sapiens fossils yet found. Genetic evidence indicates that modern humans emerged in Africa as a distinct species about this time.






Nuremberg Principles
