



The Uninsured Population of Greater Houston is larger than the entire population of 12 states.





Understanding our Gaps


- Texas:
- 28% of Texans under age 65 were insured in 2004.
- Texas ranked last among states for insurance coverage.
- Houston:
- Screening resources for underserved women were at capacity
- -Harris County Hospital District handles less than 30% of the total uninsured population.
- Disparities in breast cancer mortality rates found
- -Long wait times for diagnostic and treatment services complicate treatment outcomes and options








































