- **Reduce Premature Deaths of Infants, Children, and Adolescents**

## *Healthy People 2000 Goals*

- Increase span of healthy life
- Reduce health disparities
- Increase access to clinical preventive services
- Age specific targets continued

- Increase quality and years of healthy life
- Eliminate health disparities

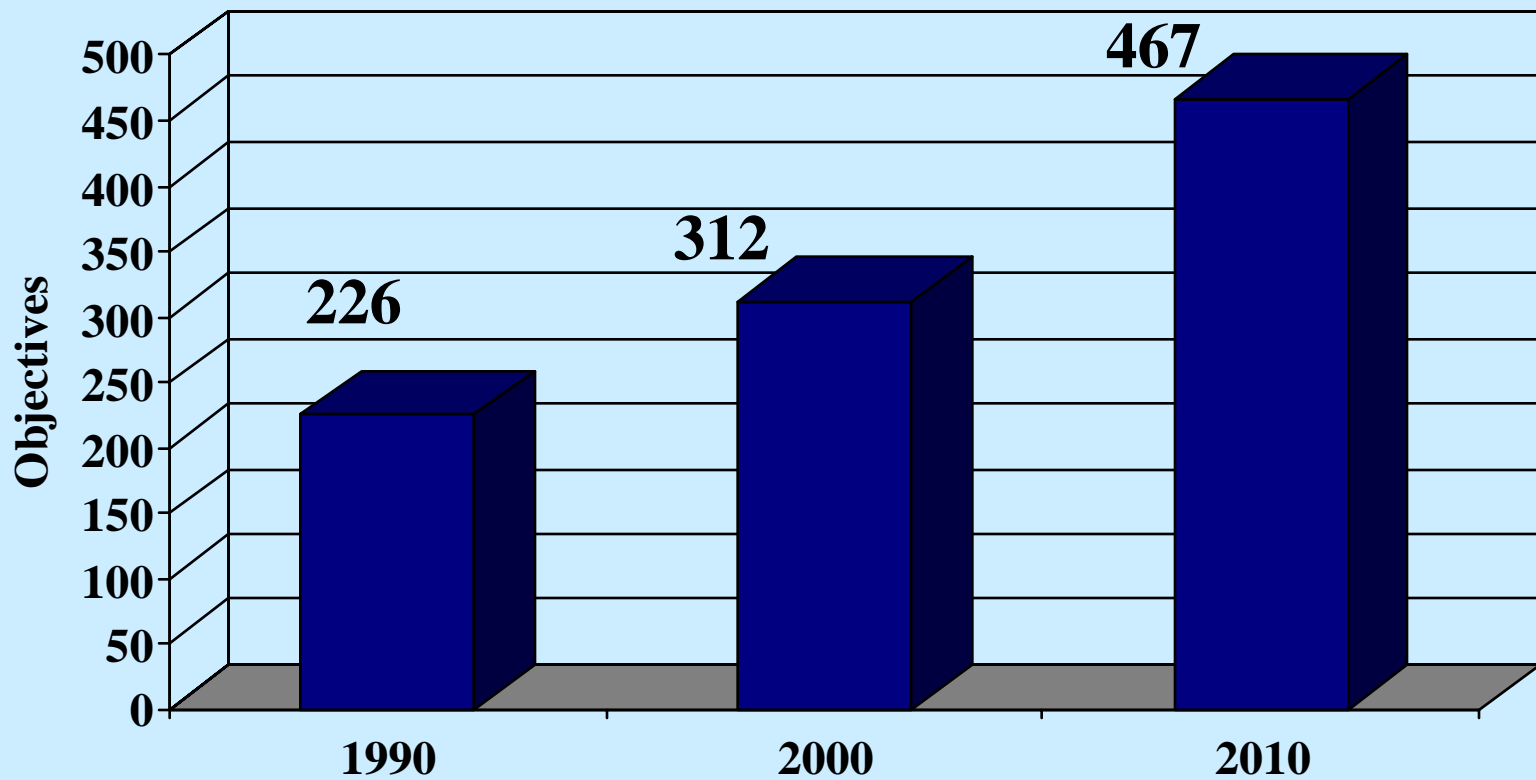

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# Office of the Regional Health Administrator

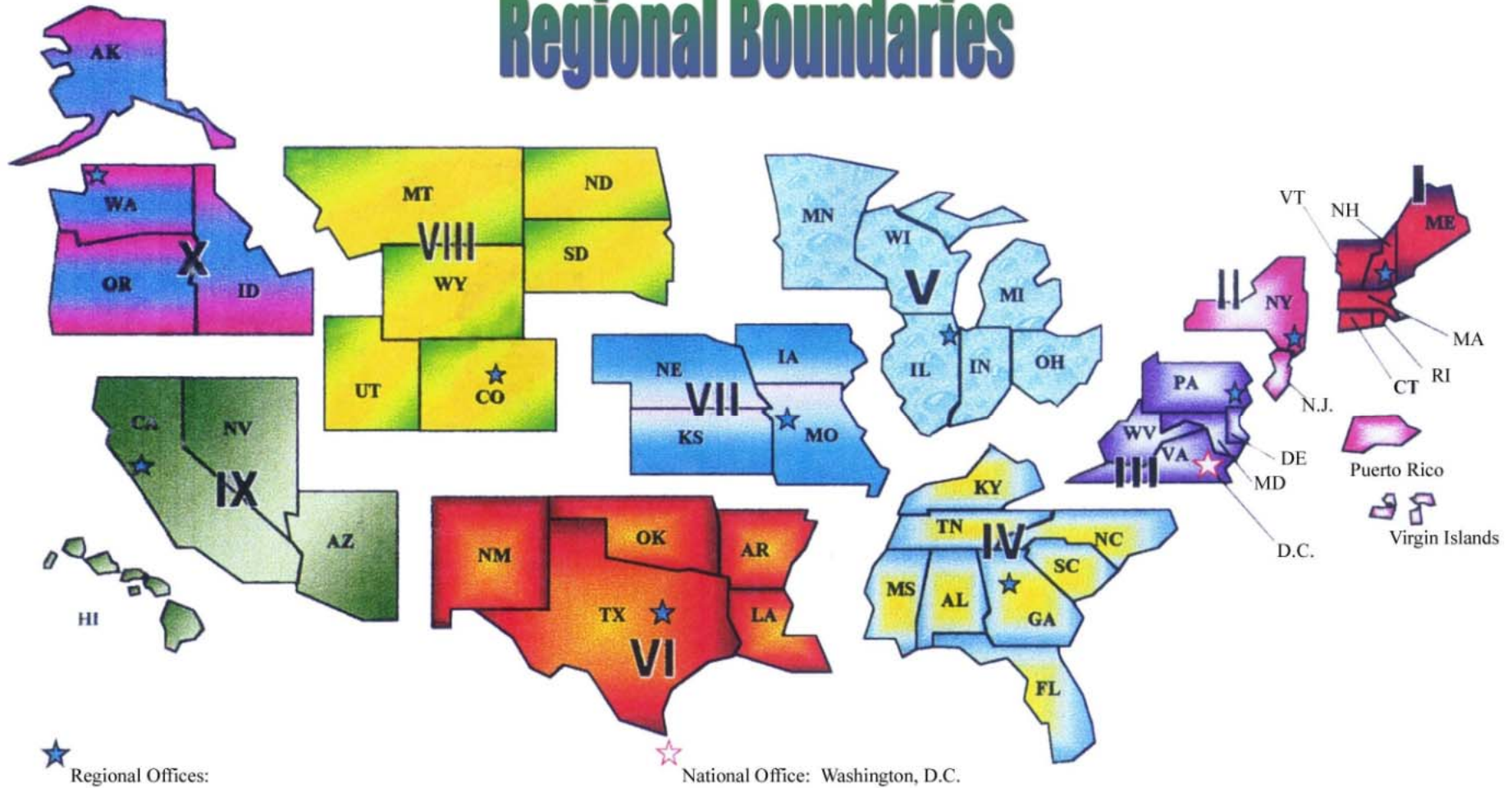
- US is divided up into 10 Regional Offices

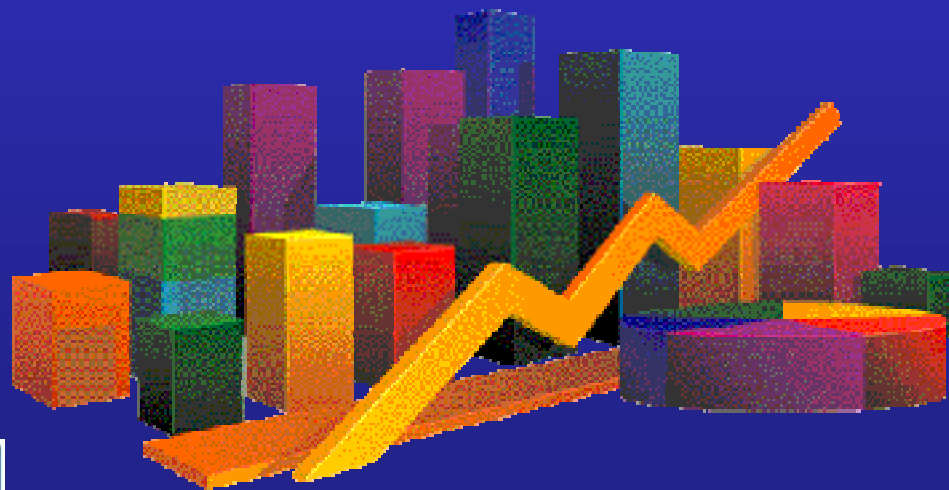
