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### **Baccalaureate Degree**

- Needed (no argument)
- However....let's assure
  - Quality of baccalaureate education in regards to this specialty
  - Accessibility of RN to BSN (or RN to MSN) education for public health nurses





### Quality: Curriculum Related Issues

- Include public health nursing (PHN) in standards for baccalaureate education
- Articulate competencies for PHN (and PHN related competencies for baccalaureate graduates)
- Work with National Council of State Boards of Nursing regarding NCLEX exam





## Quality: Faculty Issues

- Sufficient and well prepared faculty
  - Public/community health, nursing, and teaching/learning
  - Masters, PhD, DNP
- Encourage and facilitate
  - Continued learning
  - Faculty practice





## Accessibility: Education for Practicing Public Health Nurses

- Share best practices in teachinglearning
  - Distance Teaching-Learning
- Encourage development of associate degree/baccalaureate degree articulation programs (2 + 2 programs)
