Principal causes of maternal death

- Hemorrhage
- Obstructed and prolonged labor
- Sepsis
- Hypertensive diseases
- Complications from unsafe abortion

Emoc signal functions

1. Parenteral antibiotics

- 2. Parenteral oxytocic drugs
- 3. Parenteral anticonvulsants
- 4. Manual removal of placenta
- 5. Removal of retained products
- 6. Assisted vaginal delivery
- 7. Neonatal resuscitation
- 8. Surgery (e.g. cesarean delivery)
- 9. Blood transfusion






Parenteral anticonvulsants

- Treatment of severe pre-eclampsia
- Treatment and prevention of eclampsia
- Magnesium sulfate
- Diazepam





Availability of magnesium sulfate by facility level




Removal of retained products of conception


Treatment of complications of abortion

- Manual vacuum aspiration (MVA)
- Dilatation & curettage (D & C)
- Misoprostol

Availability of MVA and D&C equipment




Availability of MVA by facility level




Assisted vaginal delivery

- Treatment of prolonged labor, maternal exhaustion, fetal distress
- Vacuum extraction
- Forceps

Availability of vacuum extractor and forceps




Availability of vacuum extractor by facility level




Ambu bag and mask

Magnesium sulfate: Policy, training, management

In many countries:


- Magnesium sulfate not on essential drug list
- Drug companies see no financial advantage to register and sell
- Lower level facilities not authorized to administer; some cadres of workers not allowed to administer
- Health workers perceive magnesium sulfate as dangerous to women; don't trust their own ability to administer; long use of other drugs

Removal of retained products: Policy, training, management

In many countries:

- Lower level facilities not authorized to perform MVA
- Physician-only requirements to perform MVA
- Pain management often missing
- Providers reluctant to switch to MVA

Assisted vaginal delivery (AVD): Policy, training, management

In many countries:


- Debate over performing AVD where there is no operating theatre
- Training increasingly difficult to obtain for any level of provider
- Poor adherence to protocol
- Concerns about HIV vertical transmission may limit use of AVD
- Fewer AVDs may contribute to over use of cesarean delivery

Newborn resuscitation: Policy, training, management

Less controversial than other signal functions

- Training (1 day sufficient)
- Supply and maintenance of equipment





- Champions are needed to:
 - Provide support and encouragement
 - Mentor and coach
 - Try new strategies
 - Stay on top of things if not in front
 - International leadership for raising standards and evidence
