Begin with public health program planning


Common Model of Public Health Program Needs

- Funding Government
- Approval Senior officials initiate process
- Driven by funding priorities
- Scientific data driven, outcome oriented
- Data for central analysis
- May involve a Single agency/profession

Contrast with Death Review (focus more on the line)

- Often little or no new funds
- Line initiative with senior "accept process"
- Driven by personal passion / pain
- Problem oriented, often from terrible death
- Data for line staff case management
- May involve a diverse peer group
- And is spreading rapidly...



Death Review Products – Expanded or Improved

- Data collection
- Agencies connected to each other
- Case management,
- Prevention programs
- Formal study for professionals
- News for public education



Consider, teams may...

- Begin with informal peer support and no funds
- Continue even after official support withdrawn,
- Connect while federal agencies/projects are separate
- Share records across "forbidden" lines,
 - Geographic (city, county, state, nation)
 - Agency / Profession
 - Mix philosophies
 - Criminal justice sanctions / little service
 - Human services prevention / avoid sanctions
- Teams and sub-teams may define themselves


Death Review is not just technical

- Technical e.g., data systems, studies...
- Personal e.g., people die and we feel bad
- <u>Cultural</u> slow attitude change about
 - Mixing professions and jurisdictions
 - Following female leaders
 - Protecting people vs. protecting records
 - Being accountable e,g., measuring ourselves

Data Problems Needing Cultural Change

- Multiagency data systems poorly connected
 - Line needs this for case management
- Infant Data lost Los Angeles to Sacramento
 - State final numbers miss 1/3+ cases
- Record Confidentiality Conflicts with CAPTA
 - Even HIPAA may allow record sharing
 - Some courts/laws are moving to sharing
- Varied, separate records—by jurisdiction

Infant Homicide Rates / State Vary up to 300% with little study



CASE INTAKE VARIES also a "cultural/political" issue

- Some teams only review CPS cases
 - Miss suspicious deaths (estimate 50% 75%)
 - avoids accountability for most agencies
- Some team only retrospective
 - Avoid chance to assist in case management
 - Allows agencies to hide their work.
- Prospective review of <u>all</u> suspicious death can change case and system management


A multiagency Team Can Resolve the "Puzzle"

Ten week old falls from couch to floor Taken to closest hospital (in a neighboring state)
And... dies



FBI UCR SHR - Dad suspect (Local Police)

Coroner- Undetermined (neighboring state)



Child Abuse Central Index, No Report (Local CPS) Suspicious Death (local Child Death Review Team)

Then... understand the death

Multi-agency data - LA County, FCI Family and Children's Index

- Inspired multi-contact child deaths
- Agencies can query, child adult address
 - If there is a hit contact other agency for data
- Legal opinion
 - Share confidential information hazardous
 - Failure to protect children hazardous
- Informal study of 20 home visitor family
 - Found CPS records on... mothers

FUTURE PROGRAMS

- Regional networks counties and states
 - Australia and New Zealand have a multinational team
- Mixed family homicide (adult and child victim)
 - Dad kills kids to get back at mom
- Nonfatal child injury review (multiple states)
 - California building protocols
- Grief Support Agency Children (Foster and Delinquent)
 - National Child Grief Conference LA, March 08
- Data for line (LA Family/Children's Index)
 - Home visiting program 20 infants, found hits on... mother
