to understand the *composition*, *utilization*, and *impacts* of the *finances* that fund all components of the *public* health system


Public Health Systems Research

A field of inquiry examining the organization, financing, and delivery of public health services at local, state and national levels, and the impact of these activities on population health......

Definition

Public Health Finance is a field of study that examines the acquisition, utilization, and management of resources for the delivery of public health functions and the impact of those resources on population health and the public health system.










Percent distribution of core expenses, by function: Fiscal year 2006




Percent distribution of core expenses, by function: Fiscal year 2006




Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2006




Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2006




Graduation rates of full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by race/ethnicity: 1999 cohort







Full-time equivalent staff by assigned position: Fall 2005




147 Indicators and Ratios Provide Detailed Analysis
