- Disseminate Outdoor Worker Sun-Safety Kits designed for outdoor-based work sites (road/building construction emphasis);
- Promote integration of sun-safety measures (education, policy, increased campus shade cover) within school systems;
- Provide technical assistance to organizations developing sun-safety guidelines and educational tools:

Conduct media campaigns to promote sun-safety practices to the public.
