



#### **AMA** and Immunizations

- "Adult Immunization and Influenza" a center of excellence
  - Adult immunization is the primary objective
    - Annual vaccinations (Influenza) and lifetime immunizations (e.g. Hepatitis B, Tdap, Zoster)
    - Equitable distribution of vaccines
    - Adequate reimbursement for providers
    - Education for providers, staff and their patients

# Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)

- Immunizing adults against 10 infectious diseases
- Significant gaps between national adult immunization goals and actual rates
- Inconsistent supply, demand, distribution
- Administration and financing problems

#### National Influenza Vaccine Summit

- AMA and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
- Weekly updates on supply, distribution during the season
- Stakeholders
  - vaccine manufacturers and distributors
  - public health
  - medical associations
  - pharmacy

### National Immunization Congress

- February 2007
- Co-sponsored with the American Academy of Pediatrics
- To identify strategies to improve:
  - pediatric and adult immunization rates
  - access to affordable vaccinations
  - equitable distribution of vaccinations




#### Public Private Task Force


- AAP developed business case around pediatric vaccine financing

- Engaging AHIP


#### State CME Events

# Issues for State Legislators and Other Policy Makers
