Improving Access to Health Care for Children & Families who are Homeless

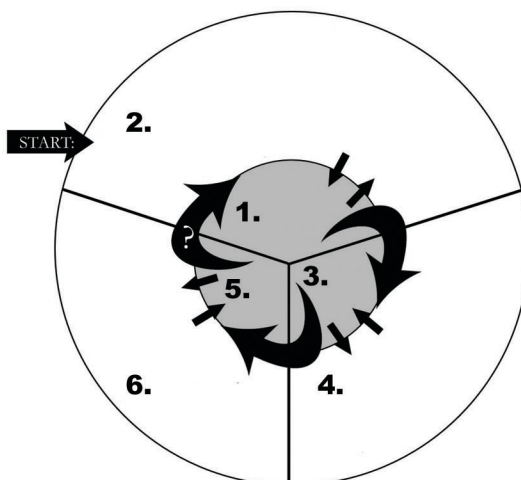
Learning Objectives:
