National Board of Chiropractic Examiners Established in 1963, NBCE develops and administers standardized national examinations according to established guidelines. In 1993, NBCE published the first practice/job analysis of the chiropractic profession, based on data collected in 1991 and 1992. Updated surveys have been performed in 1998, 2003, and 2009.























Conclusions

M

- Interdisciplinary referral of patients between chiropractors and other health providers is growing (but growth may be slowing).
- Both complementary and mainstream health providers receive patients from and send patients to doctors of chiropractic.

Discussion

M

- These data are based on self-reported monthly estimates of a previous year's practice activity.
- As such, they are liable to various biases, as well as over- and under-estimations of actual practice activities.
- Additionally, classification of provider type may have been inaccurate (e.g. nutritionist, psychologist).
