Member Comment: Every woman between the ages of 9 and 26 should be vaccinated for HPV. HPV is an STD that causes cervical cancer as well as other side effects such as gental warts that men can get as well. HPV is transferred by skin to skin contact so condoms are not very effective in protecting you.

Even if you've have had one strain of HPV the vaccination works against 4 different strains (the most common and harmful) so you should have it anyway (men hopefully the vaccination will be approved for you soon).

If you're not having sex you should still be vaccinated because men aren't tested for it and something like 75–80% of sexually active women have HPV (many have more than one strain)...and you never know when something unexpected could happen (please also note that the vaccination is currently only approved for women 9–26 so get it before it's

found out almost a yr and a half ago that I have HPV. I do not have cancer yet but I still continue to have PAP smears every three months. I have had abnormal cells found and removed during coloscopies. Although the widespread use of Pap testing has reduced the incidence and lethality of cervical cancer in developed countries, the disease still kills several hundred thousand women per year worldwide. A recently approved HPV vaccine that blocks initial infection with several of the most common sexually transmitted HPV types may lead to further decreases in the incidence of HPV-induced cancer (Lowy and Schiller 2006). I know where my disease came from and he does not believe me, which is not surprising there are no tests available for men to find HPV. I hope that he has increased his caution level since. NOT even condoms can prevent the spread of the disease.

Everyone I just want people to be aware of this disease that has killed so many women.
