

Coalition Evaluation Survey

- 267 total responses
- Average response rate per county: 16
- 86% care about the accomplishments of the coalition
- 79% feel a sense of improving the health of the community
- 79% developed new collaborative relationships





Key Informant Interviews

This program is very important for our community. It has been a life changer for us, and for a lot of other people... there has [been] a great return on investment for the CHC program. We've had bumps along the way and it hasn't been easy... sometimes it can be overwhelming but we've made worthwhile and sustainable achievements. The county is better than it was 5 years ago.
