

What is TRAIN?

A centralized learning network of courses relevant to public health and safety, TRAIN is a dynamic system that ensures access to high quality education and training across a spectrum of formats.

Developed by Public Health Foundation in response to state requests for training that would efficiently prepare the workforce, TRAIN operates through collaborative partnerships with state and federal agencies, local and national organizations, and educational institutions.

- Continuing education offered for trainings (many available for free)
- Access both web-based and classroom-based trainings
- Locate hot topic courses for particular professions & workplaces

...as a provider of training:

- Publicize your trainings to over 850,000 professionals at no cost

- Generate detailed reports on training data and participant information

...as an organization:

- Provide uniform access to national trainings and private organizational trainings
- Track training and education for all employees and others in the health workforce
- Report on public health training and education data across trainings

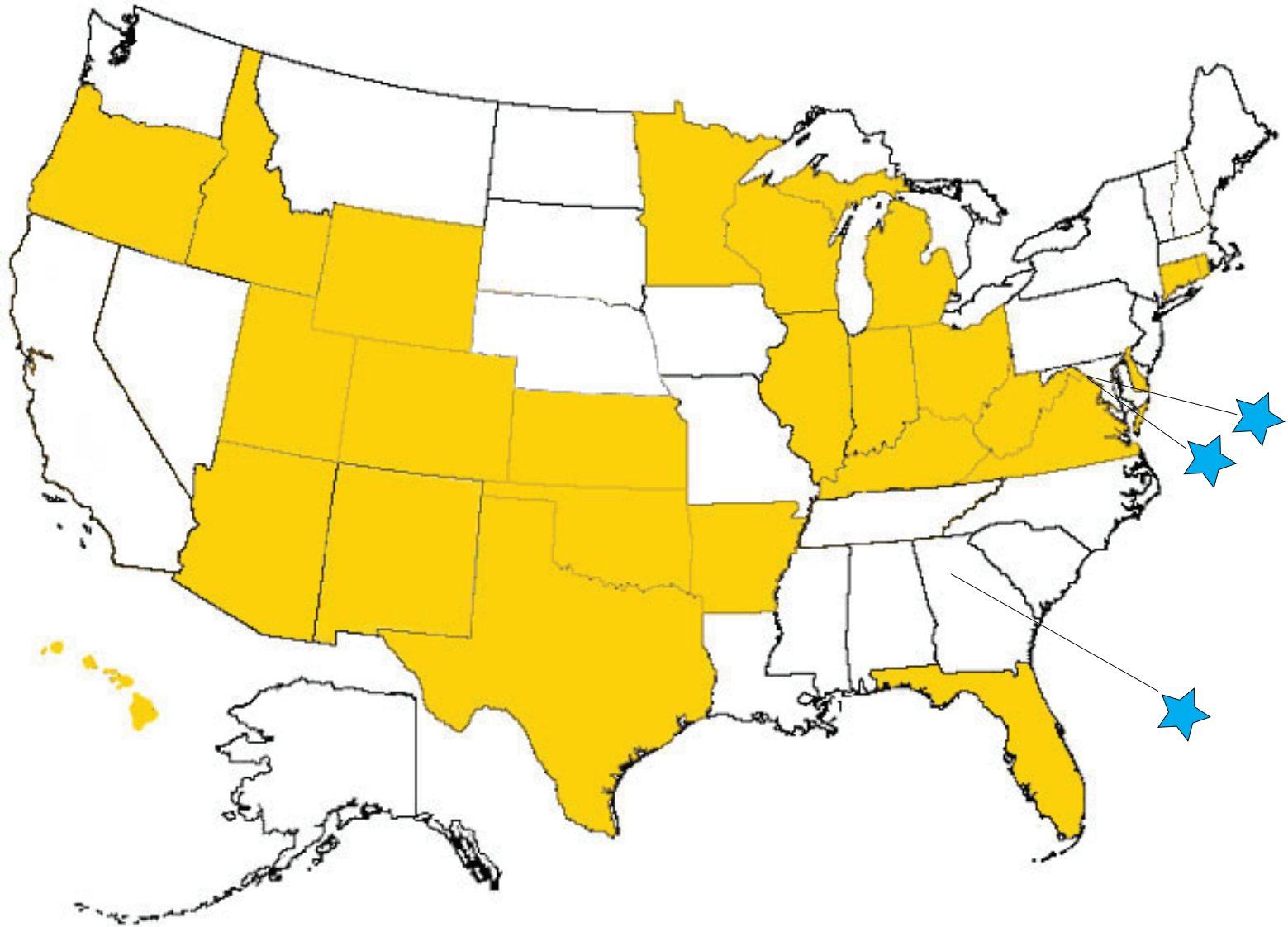
