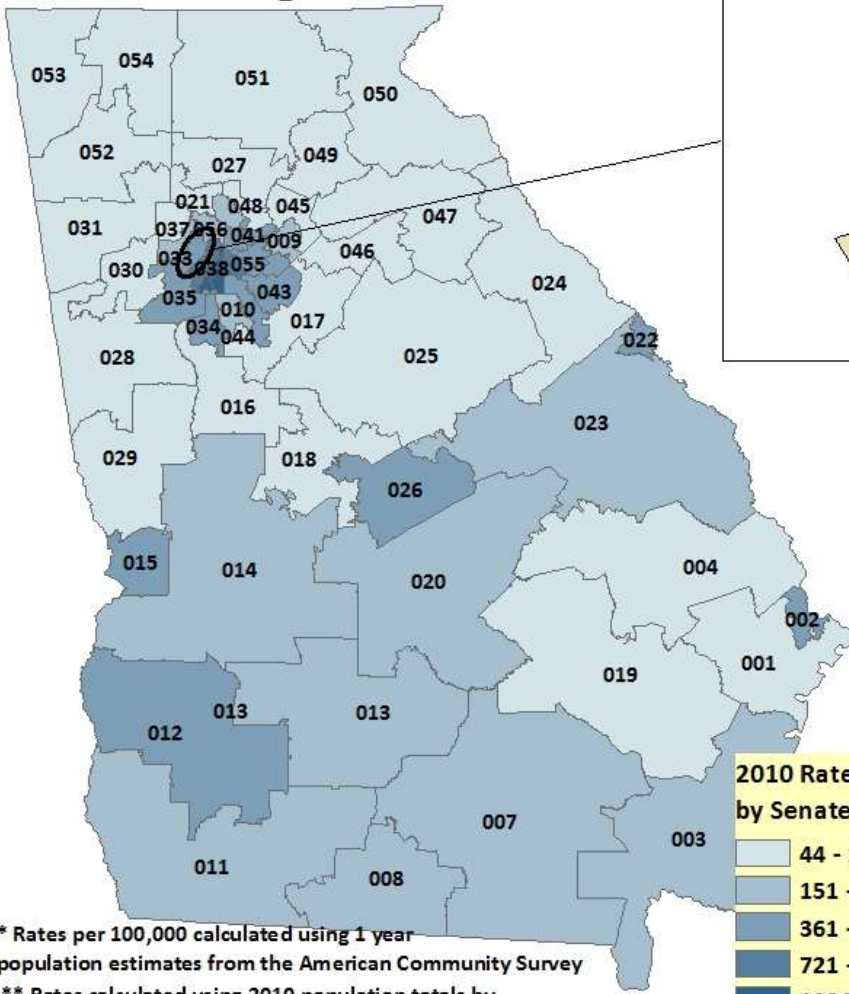


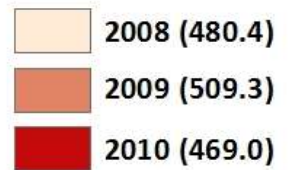
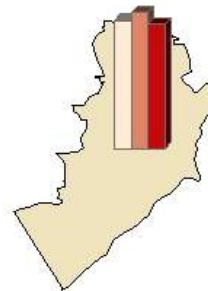

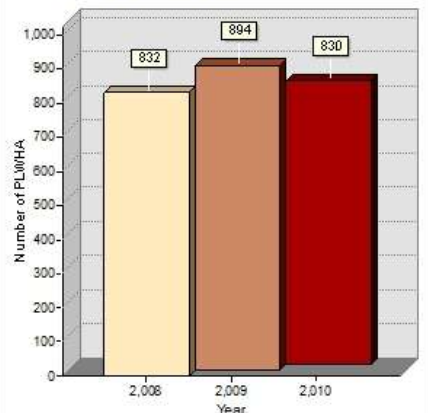

Quick Facts:

- In 2009, GA had a total of **40,328** People Living With HIV/AIDS (PLWHA), the **sixth highest** in the nation

- As of February 16, 2012, **1101** people were on Georgia's ADAP Waiting List, the **second largest in the country**
