ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME



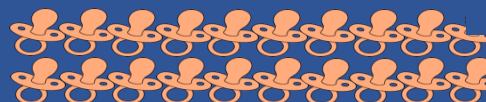

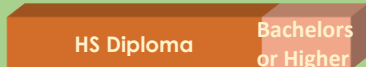

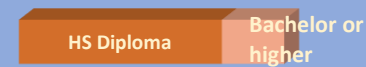
